READ:- Letter No. CL/PLN/1071/B, dated the 1st February
1971, from the Commissioner of Labour, Bombay.

RESOLUTION:- At present in the Bombay Labour Institute,
Bombay the following courses are conducted:-

- (a) Master's Degree in Labour Welfare.
- (b) Diploma in Trade Unionism and Industrial Relations.
- (c) Certificate Course in Workers' Education.

These facilities doesnot exist in Vidarbha Division and candidates from that area cannot take advantage for these courses. It is proposed to make a small beginning in this direction by starting a small Regional Institute at Nagpur. In the initial stages only the classes in Diploma in Trade Unionism and Industrial Relations will be conducted. The need for training full-time trade union workers and active trade union workers amongst the employee in the public and private sectors from industrial areas other than Bombay City and suburbs is equally urgent. The training in Diploma classes covers subjects like principles and problems of trade unionism and Industrial Relations, Industrial development, Industrial Psychology and Sociology, Statistics, Labour Legislation. It is therefore proposed to start a Diploma Course in Trade Unionism and Industrial Relations at Nagpur. About twenty students will be admitted to the class every year. The duration of the course would be nine-months. Stipends of Rs.120/- per month per student will be awarded to seven active trade unionists for the duration of the course. The minimum educational qualification will be Marathi 10th standard relaxable in case of otherwise deserving students. Rs.135/- will be charged as fees for the entire course. Visiting professors also will be invited to deliver lectures on Special topics of practical importance.

2. With the emphasis on regional planning it is necessary to have a continuous collection and analysis of data relating to labour in various regions. In the new emerging situation multiplicity of labour problems in rural and Urban areas and also in agricultural Sector are proping up. The need to develop a technique of studying and analysing these problems particularly of un-organised labour is very urgent. The Regional Institute at Nagpur would serve as nucleus for this purpose and the experience gained at Nagpur can be effectively utilised for starting similar Institutes at other regional Centres. It is also proposed to start a research wing at the Regional Labour Institute, Nagpur. The Research Wing will also serve as laboratory for the students of Diploma in Trade Unionism and Industrial Relations. Not only it will introduce them to the problems of Research Methodology but it will train these students how to conduct surveys, analyse data and draw conclusions.

3. Government is pleased to accord sanction to the opening of Regional Labour Institute at Nagpur with effect from 1st August 71. Sanction is also accorded to the starting of a research wing at the Regional Labour Institute at Nagpur 1st November 1971.

4. Sanction is accorded for the creation of the following temporary posts in the Regional Labour Institute at Nagpur with effect from 1st August 1971 till 29th February 1972 (both days inclusive):-

- 1) Rs.15000/- for payment of allowances and honoraria.
- 2) Rs.23000/- on contingencies including Rs.7560/- for pay of stipends to seven active trade unionist for the duration of the Diploma Course in Trade Unionism and Industrial Relations at the rate of 120/- p.m. per student.

6. The duration of the Course in Trade Unionism and Industrial Relations should be nine-months. The Course should be started at the Regional Labour Institute, Nagpur from 1st August 1971 this year. Twenty students should be admitted for ~~xxxx~~ each course.


CORRIGENDUM :- In the Government Resolution, Industries and
