• **All the Provisionally Eligible Candidates are Advised to Go Through the Following Instructions and Syllabus For MLS Entrance Test 2021.**

1. **MLS Entrance test for the academic year 2021-2022 will be held on 31st July 2021.**
2. **MLS Entrance test will be conducted online (CBT – Computer Based Test).**
3. **The exam center address, timing of test and other details will be share through Hall Ticket (Admit card)**
4. **The link for Downloading the Hall Ticket (Admit Card) will be shared to the provisionally eligible candidates for appearing the Entrance Test on their registered Email ID as well as on institute's website i.e. www.mils.co.in.**
5. **The Entrance Test will have one paper comprising of Multiple Choice Objective Questions. The candidates are advised to do practice because speed and accuracy is important in this kind of competitive exam.**
6. **The candidates are supposed to reach centre before the stipulated time mentioned in the Hall Ticket (Admit card). The candidates will not be allowed to enter into**

the examination centre after 10 minutes from the commencement of the examination.

7. It is mandatory to carry the Hall Ticket and carry at least one original Identity Proof which clearly shows the name and Photo as exactly matches with the Hall Ticket and Id Proof (Such as Passport, Driving License, Voter Card, Pan Card, Aadhar Card, Identity Card issued by University/ College etc.)
8. It is mandatory to follow all the guidelines in the view of Covid-19 pandemic situation issued by Govt. from time to time i.e. Social distancing, Face Mask, Hand Sanitizer etc.
9. The candidate will appear for the Entrance Examination at an allotted centre on his/her own risks and expenses, the institute will not be responsible for consequences like injury, health problem or losses etc. of any nature.
10. The authority will take action against candidates if found guilty of any misconduct, misbehavior or adopting unfair means and he/she will be disqualified from the examination.
11. No use of calculators (Separate or with watch), note books or written notes, cell phones, (with or without camera) or any other electronic device will be allowed during the examination.
12. The candidates who will provisionally selected as per the merit list of entrance test have to produce the original documents for the verification to the authority of the Institute, if the documents are found correct then the candidate will be declared eligible to take admission to the MLS course.
13. The decision of the institute/authority in all matters relating to admission process will be final and bindings on the candidates. No correspondence or personal enquiries shall be entertained by the authority in his behalf.

14. The rights to admission are reserved with the institute authority.

15. The Candidates are advised to follow the website regularly for any changes/further instructions.

- **G.K. With Special Reference to Maharashtra and Labour Movement** : History, Economy, Geography, Literature, Books and Authors, Social Workers of

Maharashtra, Agriculture Sector, Industry, Energy and Labour Sector, Constitution of India, Current political and social events, Literature and sports, Awards, External Affairs, Current Policies, and Schemes of Government, International Institution, e.g. ILO, WTO etc., Labour movement of World, Labour movement of India and Maharashtra.
